

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION - The following conditions shall be in effect for this competition:

- GSGA competitions are "spikeless" events. Therefore, metal and traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.
- Players are responsible for posting their scores to the handicap system upon conclusion of this competition. Scores must be posted as tournament scores. Course slope and rating information is typically posted at the scoreboard during the competition. You may also contact GSGA for this information. Your scores are subject to review by your peers and your club's handicap committee.

COMPETITION	Amateur Championship – Qualifying Players
ELIGIBILITY	Open to male amateur golfers who are GSGA members and residents of the state of Georgia.
FIELD	144 players
FORMAT	72 holes of individual stroke play, 18 holes each day Thursday-Sunday. After 36 holes of play, the field will be cut to the low 70 players and ties.
CHAMPIONSHIP FEE	<i>Player's advancing to the Championship will be responsible for a \$150.00 Championship fee. This fee will be due from the player upon being transferred to the Championship proper in the online registration system. The credit card used to initially register will be charged \$150.00 to complete the processing of the Championship fee.</i>
PRACTICE ROUNDS	<p>Practice rounds will be available on the designated dates and times below two weeks prior to the championship, based on club availability. Practice rounds are for players only. Please call West Lake Country Club to reserve your practice round starting time after June 30. Practice round cart and range fee is \$30 plus tax. Cash and credit cards will be accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tuesday-Thursday, anytime • Friday-Sunday after 1:00 p.m.
YARDAGES & TEES	The CHAMPIONSHIP (BLUE) tee markers and yardages will be utilized. Yardages are approximate and may be adjusted due to inclement weather or other factors that may affect the playing conditions during the competition.
GOLF SHOP & DRIVING RANGE:	The golf shop and driving range will open at 6:30 a.m. each day of the championship.
STARTING TIMES	Starting times for tournament play will be assigned by the GSGA and posted at the club the day before the competition starts. You may visit www.gsga.org for complete pairing information and starting times beginning July 6.
REGISTRATION	Formal registration will be held on site Wednesday, July 12 from 8:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. If you are not able to register in person during this time, please call the West Lake Country Club golf shop then to confirm you will be playing in round one on Thursday.

CARTS	Practice round cart and range fees are \$30 plus tax. Cash and credit cards will be accepted. Tournament round cart and range fees are included in the championship fee.
CADDIES	Caddies are permitted. Players may provide their own caddie. Caddies are not available from West Lake Country Club.
RULES OF PLAY/PACE OF PLAY/CART POLICY	The GSGA Rules of Play, Pace of Play and Cart Policies shall be in effect. Click here to view the policies.
FOOD SERVICE	GSGA will sponsor breakfast each day from 6:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. for all players. Additional F & B service will be available throughout the day at various locations in the clubhouse.
PRIZES	Gift certificates will be awarded to the low 25 finishers. The champion will also receive an additional reward.
